

Training Class Policies

1. **Basic Manners Class:: NO dogs the first night of class. The first night of class is orientation for the owners/handlers.**
2. Vaccination records (first class only) to include: Bordetella (kennel cough), distemper (DHLPP) and Rabies (for dogs four months and older). Dogs must have a negative fecal sample checked within the last year. Dogs that are unable to receive vaccinations for health reasons must have documentation from their veterinarian stating that the dog is free of disease within thirty days prior to the start of training class. Owners/handlers enter their dog(s) in the class at their own risk. Dogs will not be permitted to participate in class without proper documentation of vaccinations.
3. You will need a four or six foot nylon or leather leash; we do not accept retractable leashes in our classes.
4. A treat bag that contains soft bite-sized treats. And bring a hungry/slight hungry dog.
5. Your clicker. One will be provided at the start of the first class.
6. All dogs must enter the facility on a leash.
7. Please be aware of other dogs in the lobby when entering and exiting. Ask before allowing your dog to visit with others.
8. Owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs and dispose of the waste properly.
9. Dogs must be supervised by an owner/handler at all times. One dog per handler only. If you have multiple pets enrolled in the same class, you are expected to find multiple handlers.
10. Children must be at least five years of age to attend class and an adult must accompany.
11. Dogs exhibiting aggressive or excessively disruptive behavior will be excused from classes.
12. Class fees are non-refundable after the first night of class.
13. Missed classes can be made up on an alternative night with prior knowledge and instructed permission. (see class attendance policy)
14. Female dogs in heat will not be allowed in class, however the owner/handler may attend.
15. If your dog comes down with a contagious illness the dog and handler may not attend the class unless cleared by a veterinarian. You may transfer to the next available class.

Payment Policy:

Payment is expected by the first night of training class. Failure to pay will result in loss of class spot. We except the following types of payment: Master Card, Visa, personal checks, cash. If you would like a receipt, please ask for one. Class spots are reserved as payment in made. (DO NOT SEND CASH THROUGH THE MAIL)

Class Attendance:

Attendance is expected every week to pass the class. Please call our office if you are unable to attend a class one night. Our staff will try to find a class that you can make (please note: not always possible to find a alternative training class for you to pick up). If weather conditions become too dangerous to have class, our staff will call you and let you know class will be canceled. We will make up that training class, we will go one week longer at the end of our sessions.
